

Walleye fishing:

- 1/8 and 1/4 jigs (any bright colors)
- Little Joe spinners (hammered copper, hammered silver, as well as any bright colors)
- road runners (any bright colors)
- berkley power leeches
- 4 inch grubs (white and yellow)
- live bait (minnows and leeches; available at camp)
- 8 pound test clear or green line
- light/medium action rods
- crank baits (8 to 15 feet of water)

Northern Pike Fishing

- 5/8 and 3/4 ounce spoons (hammered copper, hammered silver, dare devil, five of diamonds, etc)
- rattle traps
- mepps spinner baits (light body/dark skirting)
- 9 inch black steel leaders
- 12 pound test clear or green line
- medium action rod

Smallmouth Bass Fishing

- 1/4 and 3/8 ounce jigs (any bright colors)
- tube jigs 1/4 and 3/8
- 4 inch tube baits (white pearl, smoke, clown, pumpkin seed)
- shallow running crank baits
- tiny torpedo's
- jitter bugs
- super flukes (white pearl, bubble gum, green with red fleck)
- 5 inch seinko's (white pearl, pumpkin seed, green with red fleck)
- 2/0 and 4/0 hooks
- whopper poppers
- berkley power leeches
- thunder sticks
- 8 pd test clear or green line
- light/medium action fishing rod

Lake Trout Fishing

- sutton silver spoon
- three way swivels
- buzz bombs
- cow bells
- white pearl tube bait
- swim baits
- 1 and 2 ounce jigs
- 2 ounce weights
- live bait (sucker minnows)
